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- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any

Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.

- 5. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 6. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.
- 7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
- 8. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 50% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Turnover

Bidder Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Generic

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

3. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

4. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

5. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

- The intending Tenderer, in case of Prime Equipment Manufacturers shall upload
 a self-declaration on their letter-head as PDF file in Cover-I of e-tender, along with
 the tender documents, confirming that they are regular in manufacturing,
 supplying, installing, testing & commissioning of the similar equipment/item.
- 2. The intending Tenderer, in case of Authorized Distributor/ Authorised Dealer shall possess valid authorized Distributorship /Dealership license from Original Equipment Manufacturers. The tenderer shall enclose the copy of the same as PDF file in Cover-I of the e-tender while submitting the tender.

- 3. The equipment shall be in compliance to the specifications mentioned in Annexure I of the tender and shall be of the latest technology, best quality and high standards.
- 4. Any optional Accessories/Tooling, besides the standard equipment recommended for the better performance of the equipment, if offered, be provided with their full technical details including their use and advantage in a separate sheet with the tender documents. Minimum two year warranty has to be provided for the equipment.
- 5. While submitting the tender, if any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any form, the tender is liable to be rejected. If any Tenderer stipulates any condition of his own, such conditional tender is liable to be rejected.
- 6. Director, ICAR-NRCP, reserves the right to reject any tender/bid wholly or partly without assigning any reason.
- 7. **Validity:** The bid should be valid for acceptance up to a period of 180 Days. The Bidders should be ready to extend the validity, if required without any additional financial implications.
- 8. The supplier should also provide the copy of purchase order of similar equipment supplied and serviced, during last three years, if any.
- 9. **Installation, Training & Demonstration:** Bidders need to provide adequate training to the nominated persons of ICAR-NRCP at their cost. ICAR-NRCP will not bear any training expenditure. The supplier is required to done the installation and demonstration of the equipment within fifteen days of arrival of materials at the NRCP, Solapur site of installation, otherwise the penalty clause will be the same as per the supply of material.
- 10. **Mode of Payment:** For Indigenous Supplies: Payment on bill basis after supply, satisfactory installation, commissioning and performance of the equipment at Solapur and after certification by our Scientists concerned.

For Imports: -The payment shall be made through irrevocable L.C. LC will be opened on 90% value of the equipment/item on FOB value and shall be released on presentation of complete and clear shipping documents. Rest 10% will be released only after satisfactory installation and commissioning of the equipment. This will not include commission to the Indian Agent. Payment of Commission to the Indian agent will strictly be made in Indian Rupees after satisfactorily commissioning of equipments. All bank charges outside India will be borne by the supplier.

- 11. **Liquidated damages Security:** In case the firm does not complete the supply within the laid down agreed delivery period as per contract, liquidated damages will be charged @ 0.5% of the contract value per week subject to maximum of 10% of the value of the order can be imposed. However, the Institute reserves the right to either further extend or cancel the contract after expiry of delivery date and recover the liquidated damages from the dues of the firm or by legal means.
- 12. **Insurance:** As applicable in the case of imported goods. For indigenous item, it will be responsibility of the supplier to supply the material in good condition on FOR basis without involving the risk of the purchaser.
- 13. **Dispute settlement:** The dispute arising out of this contract shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Indian laws & court at Solapur. Sole arbitrator is appointed by the Secretary, ICAR, New Delhi. His decision will be final and binding to both parties.
- 14. **Packing and Marking:** The packing and preservation of the supplied goods shall be airworthy/ seaworthy/roadworthy (as the case may be) so that it may provide their safety during transit period. Each packing case shall have labels as follows:

13. Certificates

14. Financial Criteria

15. Turnover

OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria. In case of bunch bids, the OEM of CATEGORY RELATED TO primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

16. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components): Supply Installation Testing Commissioning of Goods and Training of operators and providing Statutory Clearances required (if any)

17. Generic

Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.

18. Generic

Upload Manufacturer authorization: Wherever Authorised Distributors are submitting the bid, Manufacturers Authorisation Form (MAF)/Certificate with OEM details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity/restriction arising in the

bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and/or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations. Also, GeM does not permit collection of Tender fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction as the case may be. Any stipulation by the Buyer seeking payment of Tender Fee / Auction fee through ATC clauses would be treated as null and void.

This Bid is also governed by the General Terms and Conditions

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
